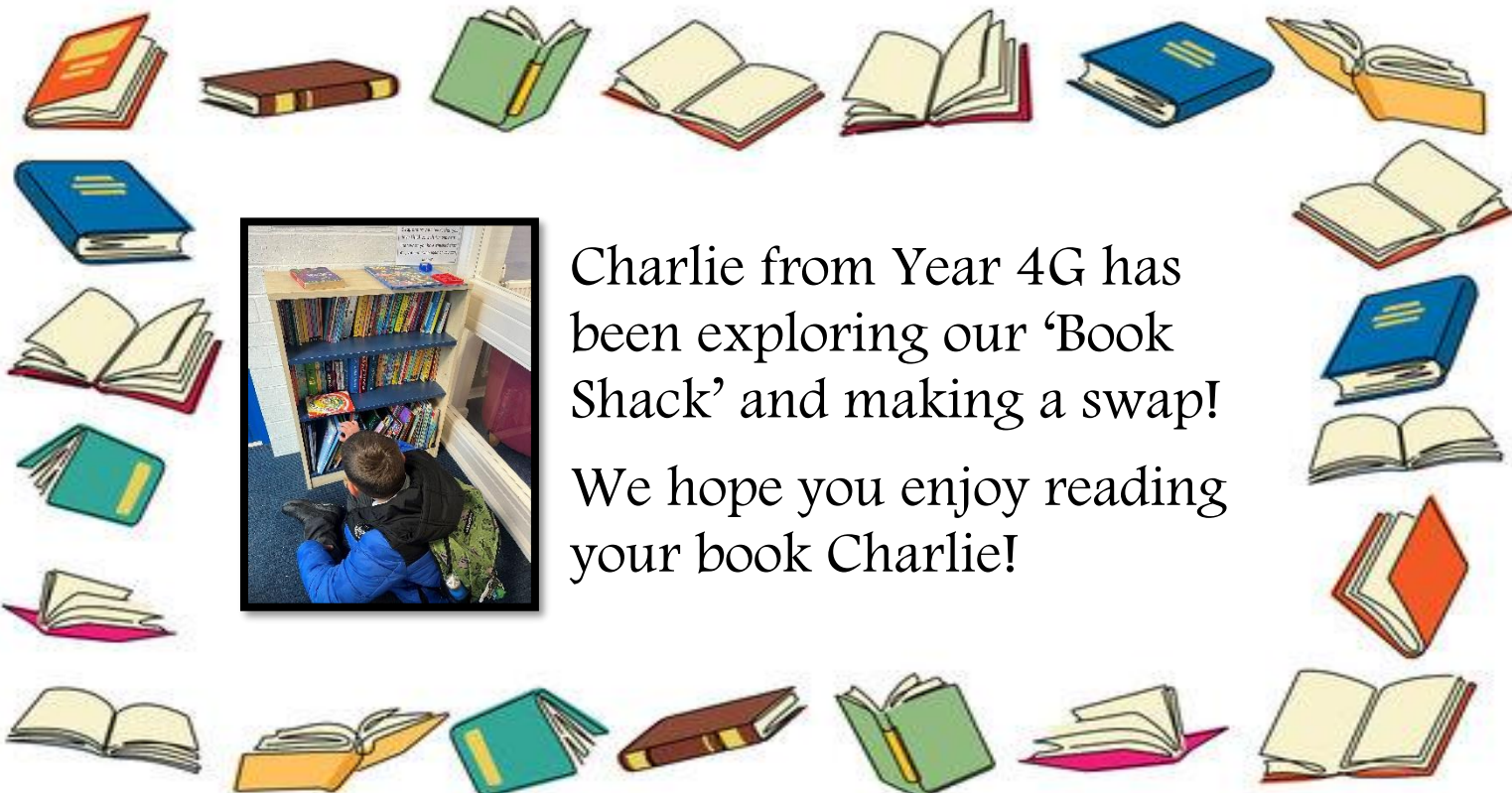
access food to eat. We politely ask that the food donations are not perishable items such as fresh vegetable, bread and fruit etc. Please send tinned or packaged items only.

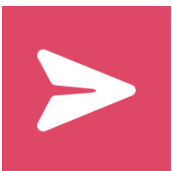
Change of contact details/address

If you have changed your address or phone number recently, please let the school office know your new details. Thank you.



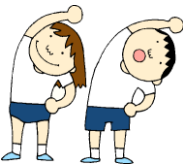
Absences/lateness
